## conditions of entry

There is a maximum of 2 entries per artist at \$25 per entry (non refundable). Approximately 70 works will be chosen by the judge to form the exhibition. Winners will be determined by the sole judge and the awards will be presented at the Gala Opening at 7.30pm on Friday 29th January 2010. Winners will be notified by telephone on the evening of 27th January. All winners are encouraged to attend; the major winner **must** attend the prizegiving.

**Originality:** The entrant must guarantee that the work is a one-off original and not of an edition. Works created in a class of instruction or under the direction of a teacher are not eligible. All works must have been created after February 2009.

**Medium:** Entries are invited from the disciplines of painting and drawing in any medium on a surface suitable for wall display.

**Size:** The longest side of the work, including frame, must not exceed 1500 mm. Weight when packaged must not exceed 30 kilograms.

**Presentation:** All entries must be in permanent materials and either securely framed or on a stretched canvas. Works must be ready for hanging and strung with strong cord using flat 'D' screw eyes.

Written on the back of the work must be:  
Artists name and address; title of work; medium used; price for sale. Plus; the same information written on a separate tag on a string that can be hung over the front of the work. This is for administrative purposes only.

**Packing:** Entries arriving by courier must be suitably crated or boxed in rigid reusable packaging with the return address clearly marked. \$20 per package freight fee must be included with the entry fee to cover repacking and return freight. Prepaid freight tickets are not an option.

**Insurance:** Insurance is the sole responsibility of the entrant. All reasonable care will be taken in the handling of all entries, but no liability for loss or damage will be accepted by Whakatane District Community Arts Council, its officers or assistants.

**Commission:** All works must be for sale. Commission at the rate of 30% of the sale price will be retained by Whakatane District Community Arts Council for works sold in the award exhibition.
